**Subject: New Prohibition Orders (PI) issued with respect to restrictive measures against Ivory Coast, Somalia, Central African Republic, Yemen and South Sudan**

1. I refer to the above subject and I wish to inform you that the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Cyprus, in exercising its powers under section 3 of the Cyprus Ships (Prohibition of Transportation) Laws 1966-1971, issued the following Prohibition Orders<sup>1</sup>:
  - (i) The Cyprus Ships (Prohibition of Transportation of Arms and Related Materiel to certain Persons or Entities in Yemen) Order of 2015, P.I. 426/2015, the measures of which have been described in DMS Circular No. 19/2015;
  - (ii) The Cyprus Ships (Prohibition of Transportation of Arms and Related Materiel to Somalia) Order of 2015, P.I. 427/2015, the measures of which have been described in DMS Circular No. 22/2015;
  - (iii) The Cyprus Ships (Prohibition of Transportation of Arms and Related Materiel to the Central African Republic) Order of 2015, P.I. 428/2015, the measures of which have been described in DMS Circular No. 18/2015;
  - (iv) The Cyprus Ships (Prohibition of Transportation of Arms and Related Materiel to South Sudan) Order of 2015, P.I. 429/2015, the measures of which have been described in DMS Circular No. 16/2015;

(v) The Cyprus Ships (Prohibition of Transportation of Arms and Related Materiel to Ivory Coast) Order of 2015, P.I. 430/2015, the measures of which have been described in DMS Circular No. 21/2015.

2. All recipients of the present Circular are invited to take note of its content and should strictly abide by the provisions of the aforementioned Prohibition Orders, DMS Circulars as well as the UN & EU Instruments implemented by virtue thereof.
