**Subject: Implementation of UN Security Council Resolution 1448 (2002)
terminating all sanctions against Angola - Repeal of Orders P.I 23/94 and
P.I. 4/2000**

1. I refer to above subject and further to my Circular No. 7/94, I wish to inform you that the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Cyprus, exercising its powers under section 3 of the Cyprus Ships (Prohibition of Transportation) Laws 1966-1971, issued the Cyprus Ships (Prohibition of Transportation) Order of 2004 (P.I. 47/2004, published in the Official Gazette of the Republic No 3802, Supplement III (I), dated 30.01.2004), which implements UN Security Council Resolution 1448 (2002).
2. UN Security Council Resolution 1448 (2002) terminates all sanctions against Angola and provides that all measures taken in relation to the prohibition of transportation to Angola of arms and related material of all types, including weapons and ammunition, military vehicles, equipment and related spare parts, as well as of petroleum and petroleum products, aircraft and aircraft components, are lifted.

3. Therefore, Orders P.I 23/94 and P.I. 4/2000 (published in Supplement III (I) of the Official Gazette of the Republic dated 4.2.94 and 14.1.00 respectively), are repealed by Order P.I. 47/2004.
