Subject: Obligations of the shipowners related to the deletion of ships from the Register of Cyprus Ships, in respect of the application of Regulation (EU) No 1257/2013 on ship recycling

I refer to the above subject and further to Shipping Deputy Ministry Circulars No. 29/2015 and 2/2017, I wish to inform you that the "**Deletion Declaration**" form is henceforth required to be submitted together with the application for deletion of a ship from the Register of Cyprus Ships.

Furthermore, in the event that the ship **will proceed for recycling**, the following documents should be submitted:

- (i) The Inventory of Hazardous Materials;
- (ii) The ship's recycling plan; and
- (iii) The "Ready for Recycling" Certificate.
