Subject: The Arms and Related Materiel (Prohibition of Transportation by Cyprus Ships of Military Equipment to the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia ,including Kosovo) Order 2002/ Implementation of UN Security Council Resolution 1367(2001).

1. Further to my circular No 2/99 dated 05.01.1999, I wish to inform you that the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Cyprus in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section 3 of the Cyprus Ships Prohibition of Transportation Laws 1966-1971 (Law 26/66 as amended), adopted the Arms and Related Materiel (Prohibition of Transportation by Cyprus Ships of Military Equipment to the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, including Kosovo) Order 2002 (Published in the Official Gazette of the Republic No 3589, Supplement III(I), dated 29.03.02, P.I 152/2002.)
2. The Order P.I.No.152/2002 in conformity with the UN Security Council Resolution 1367(2001), terminates the prohibitions imposed by paragraph 8 of Resolution 1160(1998) and therefore repeals Order P.I 242/98 to which Circular No 2/99 referred.
3. The present Circular repeals and supersedes my Circular No 2/99 dated 05.01.1999.
