Subject: SafeSeaNet (SSN) - European Platform for Maritime Data Exchange

- **Notification of Waste and Residues**
- **Notification of Security Information**
- **Notification of Dangerous or Polluting Goods (Hazmat)**

I refer to the above subject and further to DMS Circulars No. 07/2010, No. 08/2010 and No. 41/2010, I wish to inform you of the following:

In line with Article 6 of the "Reporting Formalities Directive" (2010/65/EU) and section 6 of *the Reporting Formalities for Ships Arriving – Departing from Ports of the Republic Law of 2012 (Law 148(I)/2012)*, information related to ship calls, shall be provided through SafeSeaNet. This applies to the following reporting formalities:

- Notification Prior to Entry into the Ports of Member States (section 6 of *the Merchant Shipping (Community Vessel Traffic Monitoring and Information System) Laws of 2004 -2012, Law 131(I)/2004 as amended*) - **already exchanged via SSN;**
- Notification of Dangerous or Polluting Goods carried on board (section 15 of *the Merchant Shipping (Community Vessel Traffic Monitoring and Information System) Laws of 2004 -2012, Law 131(I)/2004 as amended*) - **already exchanged via SSN;**
- Notification of Waste and Residues (*The Port Reception Facilities for Ship-generated Waste and Cargo Residues Regulations, 2003,(P.I. 771/2003)*);



- Notification of Security Information (Article of 6 of Regulation (EC) No. 725/2004).

In addition, Port State Control (PSC) related information is **already exchanged via SSN**:

- Notification 72h Pre Arrival, ATA and ATD (sections 12 and 25 of *the Merchant Shipping (Port State Control) Laws of 2011-2015* (Law 95(I)/2011).

The operator, master or agent of a ship must notify in electronic format through CYPOS of the Cyprus Ports Authority, 24 hours before the expected time of arrival at the port or anchorage or as soon as its departure from a foreign port, if the duration of the voyage is less than 24 hours (see attached **Annex**):

- Waste and Residues
- Security Information

The Waste and Residues Notification includes the following:

1. Last Port Delivered
2. Last Delivered Date
3. Delivery Status (*possible values: All, Some, None*)

The Security Notification includes the Security Level (*possible values: SL1, SL2, SL3*).

The two aforesaid notifications (Waste and Residues Notification & Security Notification) include only a summary of the information required while additional information must be provided upon request for waste and residues as per Annex II of Directive 2000/59/EC as amended (Information to be notified before entry into the port (Form CPA OP.55 is of relevance) and for security as per the existing Ship Security Pre- Arrival Form.

With regard to the Notification of Dangerous or Polluting Goods (Hazmat) which are already exchanged via SSN, it is mandatory to input the "Technical Name" of the good through CYPOS.

This **Circular** will take **effect as from 26 of April 2016** and does not annul or replace any relevant procedures currently in force.

DMS Circular No. 41/2010, dated 30/12/2010 **is hereby repealed**.
