To all Owners, Managers, Representatives and Agents in Cyprus of Ships, irrespective of flag they are flying, calling at Cyprus ports

Subject: New EU restrictive measures in view of the situation in Haiti

- 1 I refer to the above subject and I wish to inform you of the recent adoption of the following additional EU restrictive measures in view of the situation in Haiti reflected in two new legal acts adopted on 28.07.2023:
- I. Council Decision (CFSP) 2023/1574¹ of 28 July 2023 amending Decision (CFSP) 2022/2319 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Haiti:

This Decision introduces restrictive measures which include, *inter alia*, the following:

New Article 1a provides, inter alia, the following:

1. The direct or indirect supply, sale, transfer or export of arms and related materiel of all types, including weapons and ammunition, military vehicles and equipment, paramilitary equipment and spare parts for the aforementioned, to, or for the benefit of, the persons and entities listed in Annex II by nationals of Member States or from the

territories of Member States or **using their flag vessels** or aircraft shall be prohibited, whether originating or not in their territories.

- 2. It shall be prohibited to:
 - (a) provide **technical assistance, training or other assistance**, including the provision of armed mercenary personnel, related to military activities or the provision, maintenance or use of any arms and related materiel directly or indirectly to any person or entity listed in Annex II;
 - (b) provide financing or financial assistance related to military activities, including in particular grants, loans and export credit insurance, as well as insurance and reinsurance for any sale, supply, transfer or export of arms and related materiel, or for the provision of related technical or other assistance, directly or indirectly to any person or entity listed in Annex II;

New Article 3a, inter alia, provides that, all funds and economic resources owned or controlled directly or indirectly by natural or legal persons, entities or bodies, listed in Annex II:

- (a) responsible for or complicit in, or having engaged in, directly or indirectly, actions that threaten the peace, stability and security of Haiti,
- (b) undermining democracy or the rule of law in Haiti through serious financial misconduct concerning public funds or the unauthorised export of capital; or
- (c) associated with natural or legal persons, entities or bodies designated under points
 (a) and (b) or under Article 3(1),

shall be frozen.

II. Council Regulation (EU) 2023/1569² of 28 July 2023 amending Regulation (EU) 2022/2309 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Haiti:

This Regulation introduces measures in order to take regulatory action at the level of the Union to implement the measures adopted by Decision (CFSP) 2023/1574 as analysed above.
