Subject: <u>Implementation of EU Harmonising Legislation</u>: <u>The Merchant Shipping</u> (Prohibition of Organotin Compounds on Ships) Law of 2004

1. I wish to inform you that the *Merchant Shipping (Prohibition of Organotin Compounds on Ships) Law of 2004 (Law 167(I)/2004)* was enacted for the effective implementation of Community *Regulation (EC) No. 2003/782.*

- 2. The *Merchant Shipping (Prohibition of Organotin Compounds on Ships) Law of 2004* entered into force on <u>the 1st of May 2004</u> (date of accession of the Republic of Cyprus to the EU).
- 3. This Law contains enforcement measures providing for penalties against ships proven as not being in compliance with the provisions of the said Law.
- 4. Further details and requirements with regard to the effective implementation of this harmonising legislation will be communicated to you by a new Circular to be issued in the next few weeks.
