Subject: <u>Implementation of EU Harmonising Legislation: The Merchant Shipping</u> (Mandatory Surveys for the Safe Operation of Regular Ro-Ro Ferry and High Speed Passenger Craft Services) Laws of 2002-2004

1. I refer to the above subject and wish to inform you that the *Merchant Shipping (Mandatory Surveys for the Safe Operation of Regular Ro-Ro Ferry and High Speed Passenger Craft Services) Laws of 2002-2004* (Law 59(I)/2002 as amended by Law 46(I)/2004) were enacted for the purposes of transposing into our national legislation the relevant European Union *Directive 1999/35/EC* (as amended by article 10 (1) of Directive 2002/59/EC and Directive 2002/84/EC, article 9).

- The Merchant Shipping (Mandatory Surveys for the Safe Operation of Regular Ro-Ro Ferry and High Speed Passenger Craft Services) Laws of 2002-2004 are now legally in force since the 1st of May 2004 (date of accession of the Republic of Cyprus to the EU), by virtue of a Decision of the Council of Ministers of the Republic (see P.I. 255/2004 and P.I. 256/2004 published in the Official Gazette No. 3840, Supplement III(I), dated 23.04.2004).
- 3. These Laws contain enforcement measures providing for penalties against ships that may be identified as not being in compliance with the provisions of the said Laws.
- 4. Further details and requirements with regard to the effective implementation of this harmonising legislation will be communicated to you by a new Circular to be issued in the next few weeks.
