To all Registered owners, Registered bareboat charterers

**Subject: (1) Consolidated texts of European Union restrictive measures in view of the gravity of the situation in Ukraine**  
**(2) Frequently Asked Questions issued by the European Commission on Access to EU ports prohibition and on Maritime Navigation Goods and Technology**

1. I refer to the above subject and further to Circulars No.10/2014, No. 21/2014, No. 23/2014 and to Sanctions Information Notices (SINs) No. 15/2017, No.7/2018, No.1/2022, No.2/2022, No.4/2022 & No. 05/2022, I wish to inform you that the following **consolidated texts** have been made available:

consolidation however does not include the amendments introduced by **Council Decision (CFSP) 2022/660**<sup>4</sup> of 21 April 2022 amending Decision 2014/145/CFSP

IV. [Consolidated text of Council Regulation \(EU\) No 269/2014](#) of 17 March 2014 concerning restrictive measures in respect of actions undermining or threatening the territorial integrity, sovereignty and independence of Ukraine **as amended**<sup>5</sup>. This consolidation however does not include the amendments introduced by **Council Implementing Regulation (EU) 2022/658**<sup>6</sup> of 21 April 2022 implementing Regulation (EU) No 269/2014.

4. **In view of the gravity of the situation in Ukraine, it is stressed that, the relevant restrictive measures are subject to frequent review and additions by the European Union thus, it is advisable to regularly consult the links mentioned in paragraphs 2 and 3.**

6. We wish to advise that, due to the complexity of the situation which is still evolving, when seeking interpretation of the provisions of the aforementioned European Union restrictive measures, you should consider receiving expert legal advice. However, at the same time it

7. All recipients of the present Sanctions Information Notice are invited to take note of its content and should strictly abide by the provisions of *The Implementation of the Provisions of the U.N. Security Council Resolutions or Decisions (Sanctions) and the E.U. Council Decisions and Regulations (Restrictive Measures) Law of 2016 (Law 58(I)/2016)*, as well as the EU Instruments implemented by virtue thereof, and SDM Sanctions Information Notices.

**This Sanctions Information Notice, which is intended solely as a guidance document, must be placed on board vessels flying the Cyprus flag.**
