

DELETION DECLARATION¹

To: The Registrar of Cyprus Ships

For the purpose of effective compliance with the provisions of the European Union Regulation (EU) No. 1257/2013 (the Regulation²) on ship recycling, the undersigned with identity card no. / passport no. issued by the competent authorities of legally representing the registered owners Messrs (The «Company») of the Cyprus ship with Official Number (The “Ship”) acting in the capacity of [Director/ Secretary/ Managing Director/ Authorized Representative], hereby informs you of the following and confirms, in the name and on behalf of the Company, as the registered owner of the aforementioned ship that: ²

The Company does not have any intention for the recycling of the ship following her deletion from the Cyprus Registry of Ships due to reflagging.

The Company, following the deletion of the ship from the Cyprus Registry of Ships, will recycle the Ship at the approved ship recycling facility of [.....]³ which is presently, included in the relevant European List of approved ship recycling facilities published in the Official Journal of the European Union and on the website of the Commission. The required by the Regulation documents as listed below are hereby attached:

- (i) the inventory of Hazardous Materials;
- (ii) the ship’s recycling plan⁴; and
- (iii) the “Ready for Recycling” certificate

I acknowledge that any false or inaccurate statement may constitute a criminal offence punishable by virtue of the Cyprus legislation currently in force.
