New Inspection Regime on Port State Control-Notification of Ships

I refer to the above subject and further to our circular 07/2010 and 08/2010 I wish to inform you the following:

OF MERCHANT SHIPPING

LEMESOS

In line with the provisions of the recast PSC directive (2009/16/EC), information relating to ship calls shall be provided through SafeSeaNet. Also this Directive requires Member States to provide information to THETIS (the PSC inspection database) on ships' actual times of arrival and departure through SafeSeaNet (SSN) and forward pre-arrival information to the Port State Control (PSC) Authority.

Ships liable to expanded inspections (referred to in Article 9 of 2009/16/EC), are amongst others, all High Risk Ships (HRS), passenger ships, oil tankers, gas or chemical tankers and bulk carriers older than 12 years.

1.The operator, master or agent of a ship which is liable to an expanded inspection must notify its arrival at least:

72 hours before the expected time of arrival at the port or anchorage or prior its departure from a foreign port if the voyage is less than 72 hours, indicating that the ship is liable to an expanded inspection. (Please use the attached form (Annex I).

The aforesaid **72h SHIP'S PRE-ARRIVAL NOTIFICATION** is currently not possible to be provided in electronic format through the web interface (CYPOS) of the Cyprus Ports Authority which is used for the **24h SHIP'S PRE-ARRIVAL NOTIFICATION** and **HAZMAT NOTIFICATION**.

2. The operator, master or agent of a ship must notify its arrival at least:

24 hours before the expected time of arrival at the port or anchorage or prior its departure from a foreign port if the voyage is less than 24 hours. (Please use the attached form (Annex II).

3. The operator, master or agent of a ship must notify the carriage of HAZMAT on board:

Upon departing from port. (Please use the attached form (Annex III)).

In case of a cancellation of a ship visit (Please use the same forms, Annex I or II as the case may be) and enter in the field "Estimated Time of Arrival (ETA)" the code "ZZCAN"

Also in case of changes of the ETA or EDT of a ship for more than 2h then a new notification must be made to the Department of Merchant Shipping as soon as the updated information becomes known. (Please use the same forms, Annex I or II as the case may be)

The aforesaid arrangements are temporary and they will cease to be applied when a new communication interface between the CYPOS and the SafeSeaNet server of the Department of Merchant Shipping will be developed.

Your attention is drawn to the fact that in view of the above <u>you must keep making the inputs</u> for the **24h SHIP'S PRE-ARRIVAL NOTIFICATION** and **HAZMAT NOTIFICATION** through the web interface (CYPOS) of the Cyprus Ports Authority.

With regard to the Actual Time of Arrival (ATA) or Actual Time of Departure (ATD) of a vessel (referred to in Article 24.2 of 2009/16/EC), this information will be obtained by the Department of Merchant Shipping through other sources of information.

Your cooperation for the successful and efficient operation of the SafeSeaNet would be highly appreciated.
