## Subject: New European Union restrictive measures in view of the gravity of the situation in Ukraine

- 1. I refer to the above subject and I wish to inform you of the recent adoption of the following additional European Union restrictive measures in view of the gravity of the situation in Ukraine reflected in four new legal acts adopted on 27 January and 4 February 2023:
  - I. European Union restrictive measures amending Council Decision 2014/512/CFSP concerning restrictive measures in view of Russia's actions destabilising the situation in Ukraine:
    - Council Decision (CFSP) 2023/191<sup>1</sup> of 27 January 2023:

This Decision renewed Decision 2014/512/CFSP for a further 6 months, i.e. until 31 July 2023.

Council Decision (CFSP) 2023/252<sup>2</sup> of 4 February 2023:

This Decision introduces two additional price caps on petroleum products into its Annex XI, that is the price per barrel at or below which petroleum products from Russia are exempt from the prohibition to provide maritime transport and the prohibition to provide technical

assistance, brokering services or financing or financial assistance, related to the maritime transport to third countries. The **first additional price cap** relates to petroleum products traded at a discount to crude oil ('discount to crude oil') and the **second one** relates to petroleum products traded at a premium to crude ('premium to crude oil').

Articles 40 and 4p of Council Decision 2014/512/CFSP are consequently amended.

Furthermore, the following amendments are *inter alia* introduced by Council Decision (CFSP) 2023/252:

- a transitional period is introduced for vessels carrying petroleum products originating in Russia which are purchased and loaded onto the vessel prior to 5 February 2023 and unloaded prior to 1 April 2023.
- paragraph 12 of Article 4p provides that the functioning of the price cap mechanism,
  shall be reviewed by mid-March 2023 and every 2 months thereafter.
- a Table for prices for petroleum products (price per barrel in USD) is added to Annex
  XI of Decision 2014/512/CFSP.
- Annex XIII with a list of crude oil and petroleum products referred to in Articles 40 and 4p is added to Decision 2014/512/CFSP.
- II. European Union restrictive measures amending Council Regulation (EU) No 833/2014 concerning restrictive measures in view of Russia's actions destabilising the situation in Ukraine:
  - Council Regulation (EU) 2023/250<sup>3</sup> of 4 February 2023:

This Regulation introduces amendments to Council Regulation (EU) No 833/2014 in order to take regulatory action at the level of the Union to implement the amendments adopted by Council Decision (CFSP) 2022/252.

Accordingly, this Regulation introduces a transitional period for vessels carrying petroleum products originating in Russia which are purchased and loaded onto the vessel prior to 5 February 2023 and unloaded prior to 1 April 2023.

This Regulation also introduces a regular review of the price cap mechanism.

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2023/251<sup>4</sup> of 4 February 2023:

This Regulation introduces amendments to Council Regulation (EU) No 833/2014 in order to take regulatory action at the level of the Union to implement the amendments adopted by Council Decision (CFSP) 2022/252.

Accordingly, **Annex XXVIII to Regulation (EU) No 833/2014** is amended and a table for **prices for petroleum products** is added.

2. It is noted that, in relation to SIN No. 16/2022 with the respect to the Natural Gas Condensates the SDM has issued Circular No. 03/2023.

This Sanctions Information Notice, which is intended solely as a guidance document, must be placed on board vessels flying the Cyprus flag.
